



LOOKING FOR “HOPE AND JOY”

Twenty-six-year-old Lila told her Advocate she had doubts about continuing the pregnancy if her test was positive.

“My work is very labor-intensive job,” our patient said. “I’m worried about losing my job. I have a daughter to take care of, and I need to work.”

Although her boyfriend supported a decision to parent, Lila was also concerned about ruining her relationship with her parents. “This is my third pregnancy not being married, and I’m sure they’ll be disappointed.”

She had an abortion just last year, and admitted to having little joy in her life. As the Advocate discussed the Gospel with her, Lila confessed, “I’ve been looking for something to give me hope and joy.”

She said several people, including her parents, had been encouraging her to go to church, but that she had not. The Advocate assured our patient that she could have hope and joy in Jesus, and she provided her with a church referral list.

Lila’s pregnancy test was positive, so the Advocate reviewed the young woman’s pregnancy options with her. They discussed abortion and when the Advocate provided literature on abortion pill reversal, Lila said, “I’ve seen information on this

before. Now that you’re telling me more about it, maybe that’s a sign God wants me to keep this baby.”

When she saw the image of her seven-week-old on the ultrasound screen, tears formed in Lila’s eyes. Afterward, she told her Advocate she would parent. Our nurse scheduled Lila to return for a second ultrasound with opportunity to bring the father of her child and to visit with our Resource Coordinator. Lila was also given information on post-abortion healing.

We’re thankful Lila came to True Care. Here this young mom received the vital information and referrals she needed and was assured she could find hope, joy and forgiveness in Christ.

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

3. More than 65 new people were introduced to our life-saving work by attending a Vision Tour, a one-hour tour of True Care from the patient's perspective.


LOOKING FORWARD

1. **Reaching the fathers:** *Fathering in Fifteen*, a program we purchased from the National Fatherhood Initiative, is now being offered to the dads as part of the Baby and Me Program.


OPPORTUNITIES FOR INVOLVEMENT:
