# Volunteer Opportunities

## Advocate

Meets one-on-one with test patients. Provides pregnancy options consultation and works with nurses and the Resource Coordinator to evaluate patient's circumstances and needs. Provides spiritual leadership to patients, offering them peace of mind and confidence in their future through the opportunity to develop a relationship with Jesus Christ and through the community resource list given to each patient. Advocates give one, 4-hour shift per week and/or fill in as needed.

## Receptionist

Welcomes patients and guests. Serves as first contact to those coming to the Center. Greets patients, offers a beverage, answers the phone, and performs computer work, copying, filing and other office tasks. Receptionists give one 4-hour shift per week.

## Follow-Up Specialist

Provides ongoing support during the patient's pregnancy through follow-up phone calls, asking questions and providing additional referrals as needed. Follow-Up Specialists give one 2-hour shift per week and can perform their duties when the Center is closed.

## Nurse

Performs pregnancy tests, STD tests, answers pregnancy-related and medical questions, and educates patients about sexually transmitted diseases. Nurses give one 4-hour shift per week.

## Abortion Recovery Specialist

Guides patients who have had personal experience with abortion through Bible studies such as *Save One* and *Her Choice to Heal* as they seek forgiveness and healing. Time commitment varies.

## Baby and Me and Feminine Genius Program Advocates

The Baby and Me and Feminine Genius (Sexual Integrity) programs are long-term patient care programs focused on one-on-one mentoring and education with incentives for goals met. Baby and Me Advocates equip patients to be the best parents they can be, whether they choose to parent or make an adoption plan. Feminine Genius Advocates work with patients who desire to be accountable and learn to have integrity in all areas of their lives. These advocates typically give one 4-hour shift per week.

## Board of Directors

The Board consists of volunteers who have vision and passion for the ministry. They provide oversight and accountability for the CEO and set policies. Board members are expected to support the Center financially and to take part in fundraising and donor development. Time commitment varies.

## Advancement Team

Helps with mailings, copying, clerical and other administrative support duties. May also help organize and execute fundraising events such as our annual Commitment Event, Walk for Life, and Baby Bottle Campaign. Time commitment varies.

## Building and Grounds Maintenance Team

Assists with a variety of chores such as regular cleaning, maintenance, snow removal, and spring and fall cleanup. Time commitment varies.

## Prayer Team

Ensures that all the Center's programs, volunteers, staff, and patients are covered in prayer. Prayer requests are emailed weekly.
